Migrating data from Tally 4.5 to Tally. ERP 9 is a two step process:

- 1. You will first need to **convert** the data of Tally 4.5 to Tally 7.2 compatible data using 'Tally 4.5 to Tally 7.2 Data Migration' utility.
- 2. Then **migrate** the Tally 7.2 compatible data to Tally.ERP 9 using 'Tally 7.2 to Tally.ERP 9 Data Migration' utility.

Conversion of data from Tally 4.5 to Tally 7.2

- 1. You can download the Tally 4.5 data converter utility from the download page of our website http://www.tallysolutions.com
- 2. Run the **Convert45to72.exe** and extract the files to the directory where Tally 4.5 is installed. The following files will now be available in this folder:
 - a. WCVTALLY.EXE
 - b. TW45250.DLL
 - c. CNVTALLY.DAT

Run the file **WCVTALLY.EXE** (the icon is identical to the Tally Icon).

3. The **Company Info** screen is displayed. Select the company you want to be migrated. You will be asked to confirm the conversion/migration.



Migrating Tally 7.2 data to Tally.ERP 9

- 1. Install Tally.ERP 9.
- 2. Run 'TallyMigrateData' utility from Start > Programs > Tally.ERP 9 > Tally ERP 9
 Data Migration. You can also run the migration utility by double clicking the tally72migrate.exe file located in the folder where Tally.ERP 9 is installed.
- 3. The utility will launch the Tally Data Migration Tool and Tally.ERP 9.
- 4. Select Migrate Data in the Migration Company screen.
- 5. **Specify the directory** where the converted Tally 7.2 data is located in the **Directory** field.
- 6. Select the company from the **List of Companies**.
- 7. The Data Migration utility will load the data of the selected company and ask for a confirmation.
- 8. Select 'Yes' and start the migration of the selected company.
- 9. The status of migration from Tally 7.2 to Tally.ERP 9 is shown in the Migration Messages Pane.
- 10. When migration is completed, it displays the message **Migration Completed Check Statistics (press any key)**.

By default, the migrated company is saved in the same directory specified (refer point 5 above). The migrated data folder is prefixed with a **'0'** and appears as a **5** digit number. For example, if the company folder number before migration was '0099', then after migration it would be '00099'. You are advised to copy this folder to the data folder of Tally.ERP 9.

Your migrated data is now ready for Tally.ERP 9.

Note: Any error occurring during migration is logged into the file 'migration.err' that is available in the folder where Tally.ERP 9 is installed.
